English words can be classified into parts of speech. Three of those parts of speech are nouns, pronouns, and adjectives.

Parts of Speech			
Noun	names a person, place, or thing	Jason office	fence kindness
Pronoun	takes the place of a noun in a sentence	I You	Me You
		He She	Him Her
		It We	It Us
		They	Them
Adjective	describes a noun or pronoun	short heavy	bright rainy
